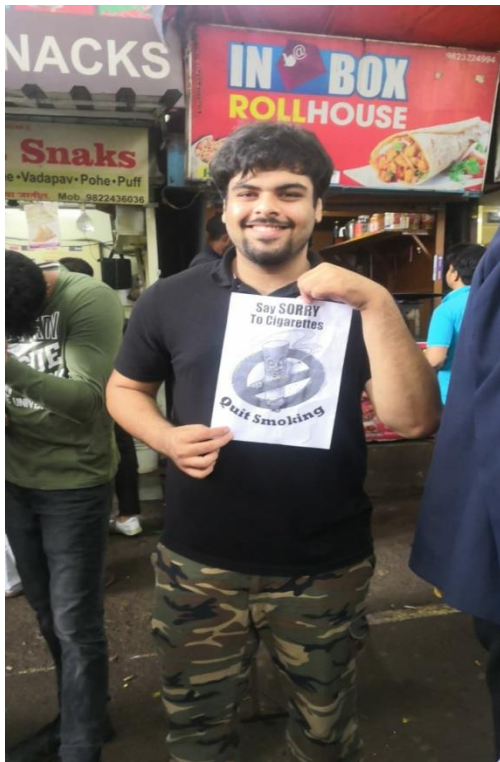
The activity started at 1:00 pm and ended at 2.00 pm and the activity was performed outside the Bharati Vidyapeeth University gate near the food courts.

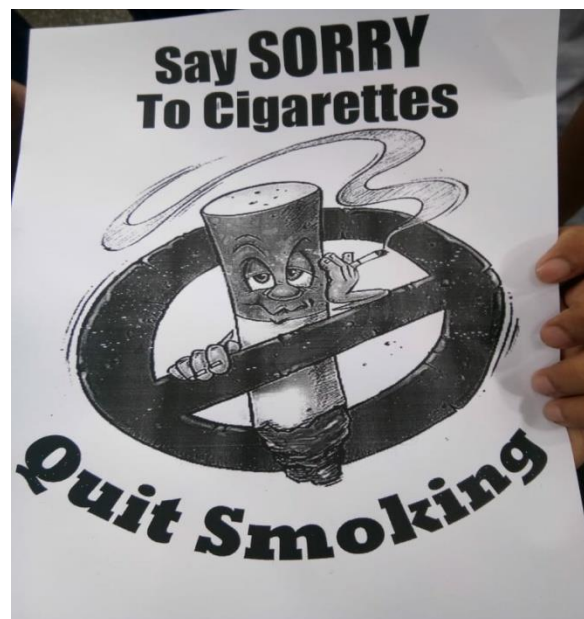

FLOOD RELIEF CAMP

In the month of August the various districts of Maharashtra had to suffer from flood in which kolhapur, satara and sangli were the majorly affected districts. In sangli district under Palus tehasil, 19 villages were affected in which BURLI was selected for the flood relief camp.

The NSS unit of IMED planned a flood relief camp in order to provide support to the people of BURLI, PALUS to stabilize the situation. On 1st AUGUST 2019, due to heavy rainfall and overflow of water of Krishna river, the village has to suffer from flood. The water remained there for more than 10 days and the height of the water was more than 10 feet. This flood was so disastrous that it went off all the essentials of people within it. It caused huge damage which includes the death of several household animals, the loss of lives of people and the damage to the agricultural lands. In just a moment of seconds everything got changed for the people of BURLI.

So in order to help the people out there, NSS volunteer along with the faculties on 11th AUGUST 2019 went there and tried to bring back the people to their normal condition. The places covered by the volunteers included

- I) Zilaparishad Boys school No.2
- II) Zilaparishad Girls school
- III) Suvivek Anganwadi no. 119 BURLI
- IV) Gram panchayat, BURLI
- V) Anganwadi

There were total 25 volunteers who went there along with two faculty members. The work done by the volunteers were very admiral and appreciable. All in all the volunteers tried to help the people to overcome this disastrous situation.

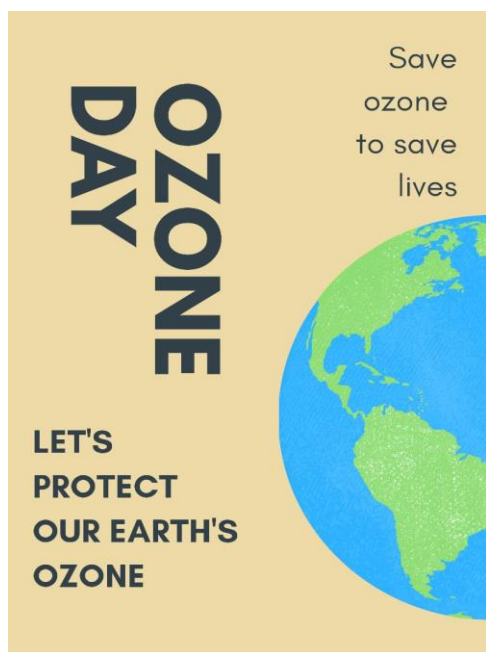

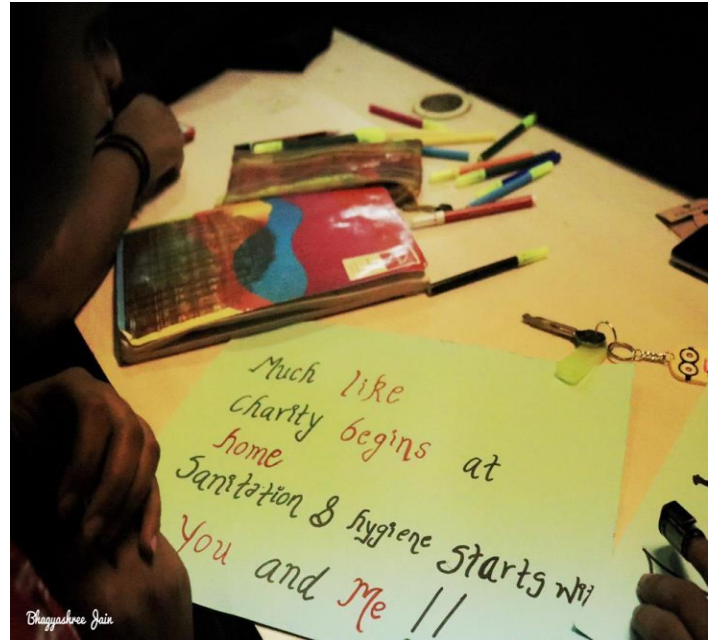
IMED CLEANLINESS DRIVE

This year whole country faced a lot of problem due to heavy rains. One of the states facing most of the rainfall was Maharashtra.

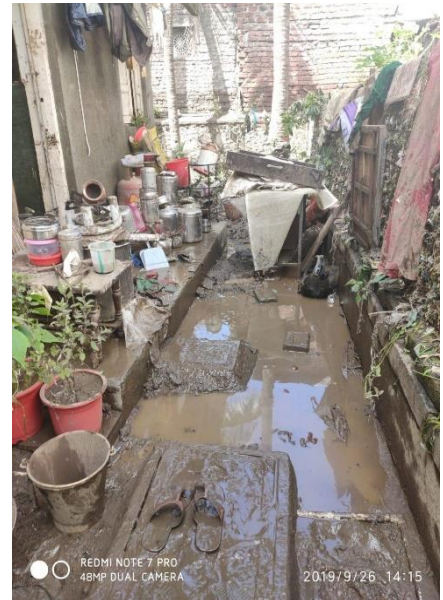

TULSI PLANTATION

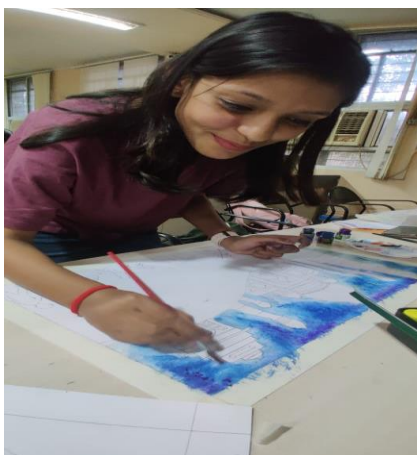

Date: 22nd March 2020



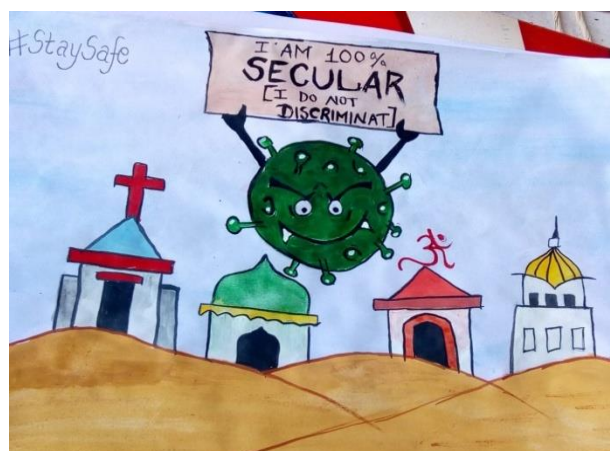
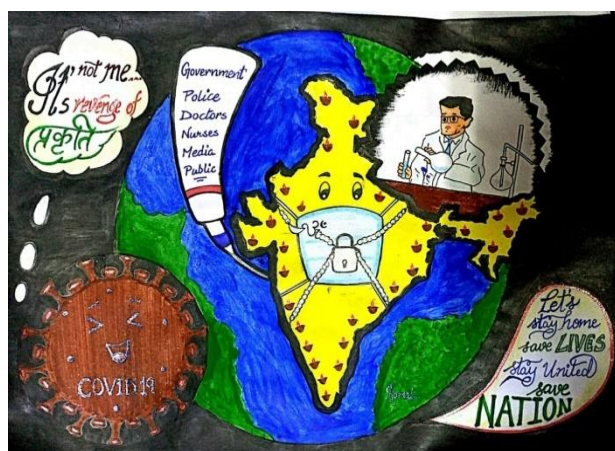
